Santa Fe Hestia has Record-Breaking Year for Giving

Grants to Santa Fe institutions providing services to middle-school children will equal \$165,386 in 2019, our **highest amount to date**. Sixteen programs will receive funding including three for the first time including Community Learning, Site Santa Fe and Wise Fool. In 2018, we awarded our first multiple-year grants to Communities in Schools and Gerard's House. Both of these organizations will receive a second installment of funding in 2019.
