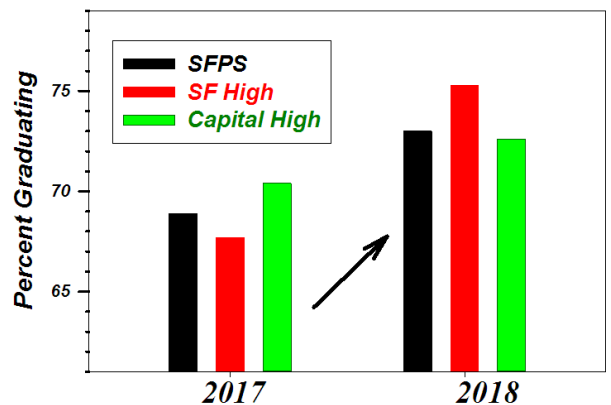


Better Graduation Rate in Santa Fe
